# **Warm Home Discount Scheme**

#### 1. Overview

You could get £140 off your electricity bill for winter 2018 to 2019 under the Warm Home Discount Scheme.

The money is not paid to you - it's a one-off discount on your electricity bill, between September and March.

You may be able to get the discount on your gas bill instead if your supplier provides you with both gas and electricity. Contact your supplier to find out.

The discount will not affect your Cold Weather Payment (https://www.gov.uk/cold-weather-payment) or Winter Fuel Payment (https://www.gov.uk/winter-fuel-payment).

#### **Eligibility**

There are 2 ways to qualify for the Warm Home Discount Scheme:

- you get the Guarantee Credit element of Pension Credit (https://www.gov.uk /the-warm-home-discount-scheme/guarantee-pension-credit) - known as the 'core group'
- you're on a low income (https://www.gov.uk/the-warm-home-discount-scheme /low-income) and meet your energy supplier's criteria for the scheme - known as the 'broader group'

How you apply for the Warm Home Discount Scheme depends on how you qualify for the discount.

### Pre-pay or pay-as-you-go meters

You can still qualify for the discount if you use a pre-pay or pay-as-you-go electricity meter.

Your electricity supplier can tell you how you'll get the discount if you're eligible, for example a voucher you can use to top up your meter.

### Park (mobile) homes

You apply a different way (https://parkhomeswhd.com/) if you live in a park home.

# 2. If you get the Guarantee Credit element of Pension Credit

You qualify for the discount if on 8 July 2018 all of the following applied:

- your energy supplier was part of the scheme (https://www.gov.uk/the-warm-home-discount-scheme/energy-suppliers)
- your name (or your partner's) was on the bill
- you were getting the Guarantee Credit element of Pension Credit
  (https://www.gov.uk/pension-credit/) (even if you get Savings Credit as well)

This is known as being in the 'core group'.

## How to apply

You'll receive a letter by 7 December 2018 telling you how to get the discount if you qualify.

Your letter will say if you need to call a helpline by 28 February 2019 to confirm your details.

Your electricity supplier will apply the discount to your bill by the end of March 2019.

#### If you did not get a letter

Contact the Warm Home Discount Team if you did not get the letter and you think you're eligible for the 'core group'.

Do not contact the Warm Home Discount Team if you're not eligible for the 'core group'. Check if you're eligible to apply another way (https://www.gov.uk/the-warm-home-discount-scheme/low-income).

## 3. If you're on a low income

You may be able to apply directly to your electricity supplier for help if you do not get the Guarantee Credit element of Pension Credit but:

- your energy supplier is part of the scheme (https://www.gov.uk/the-warm-home-discount-scheme/energy-suppliers)
- you're on a low income
- you get certain means-tested benefits

This is known as being in the 'broader group'.

To get the discount you'll need to stay with your supplier until it's paid.

#### How to apply

Your electricity supplier decides who can get the discount - check with your supplier to see if you're eligible and how to apply.

Check with your supplier as early as possible. The number of discounts suppliers can give are limited.
