

Budget 2024/2025 : Summary

Budget 2024/2025 : Neighbourhood Plan

Neighbourhood Plan needed to help protect from holiday lets / second homes, and to preserve green space.

Total cost estimate: £15-20k, over 18-24 months.

- 2023-2024: £15k expense and £10k income. Nothing done
- 2024-2025 : £15k expense and £5k income!

Grants available to cover the cost. Why £30k expense total?

Budget 2024/2025 : Double Devolution

Opportunity to take on assets / services from NYC. WTC bid for control of some parks / green space.

- 2023-2024 : £12.5k allocated. Spent on what?
- 2024-2025 : £12.5k more!

If WTC cannot manage their current assets / services (e.g toilets), should they really be bidding for more services?

Budget 2024/2025 : IT

- Website: Added expense of £2.5k to provide new council website
 - Current website is poor
 - Website only good if up-to-date / maintained
- Computer tablets: Not included in budget. Not essential.

Budget 2024/2025 : Christmas

- Festival: £50k expenditure with £52.5k income
- Lights: £25k expenditure with £10k income from NYC as part payment

Many street lights don't work, so Christmas lights don't either

Budget 2024/2025 : Other Costs

- Audit: Increased by £20k due to issues with the 2022-2023
 AGAR, now taken to Stage 3 by external auditor. £10k / year –
 so why £20k?
- *Elections / Polls*: Increased from £0 to £15k to pay for 1 Town Poll, and budget for 1 in the future
